1 Payment Systems and Incentives

What are the most productive payment and incentive systems for integrated care (IC) with limited financial resources? The conference will explore the experience and impact of different innovations in payment systems including: bundled payments, shared savings, population-based financing, pay-for-performance, and cooperation fees.

2 Improving Continuity of Care and Care Co-ordination

How can care systems improve continuity of care and care co-ordination for people with multiple long-term and chronic care needs? The conference will examine how care for multi-morbid patients and the frail elderly can be improved through approaches to care that better support people with complex care needs.

3 Organizational Solutions

What organizational solutions are most conducive to the optimal provision of integrated care? The conference will debate the pros and cons of creating new integrated care organizations versus co-ordinated networks of care. It will also examine the importance of key organizational functions such as leadership, governance, and information technology. How to assess outcomes?

4 Implementation Strategies that Deliver Change

What strategies are required at a system level to support the adoption of IC solutions 'at scale'? The conference will debate what policy-makers and system leaders need to do to provide a supporting environment for integrated care, including the appropriate balance between 'top-down' national directives versus the freedom to allow 'bottom-up' innovations.
